- ② Thesis: Students must earn a Pass on the Thesis requirement (both IB & IR students). Graduation can be delayed if students miss deadlines for submitting their completed Thesis, stage by stage (see date listed below). The "Thesis Writing" course is not a required course. However, it is strongly recommended that students take this course as it can save much time and unnecessary stress that some students experience while writing their thesis.
